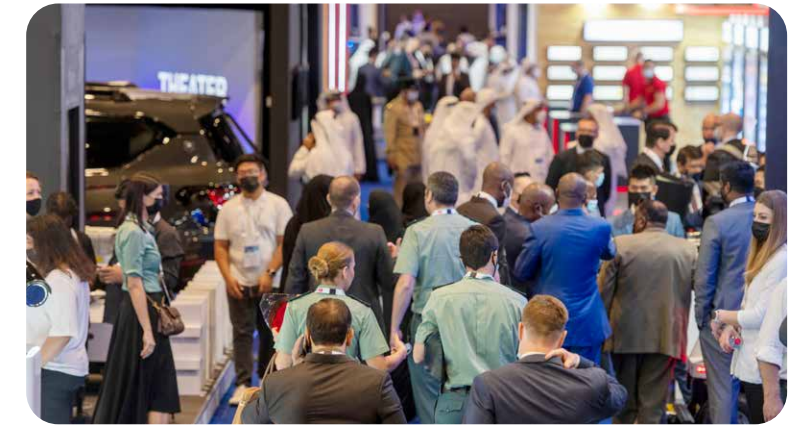




DEFINING THE FUTURE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT

OPENING CEREMONY

Officially opened by His Highness Sheikh Hamdan bin Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Crown Prince of Dubai and Chairman of the Executive Council, Government of Dubai, the World Police Summit's opening ceremony hosted an audience of over 1,300 international police leaders, law enforcement and intergovernmental officials, technology experts and policymakers to address the current challenges, future opportunities and lay the foundation for safer and secure societies.
