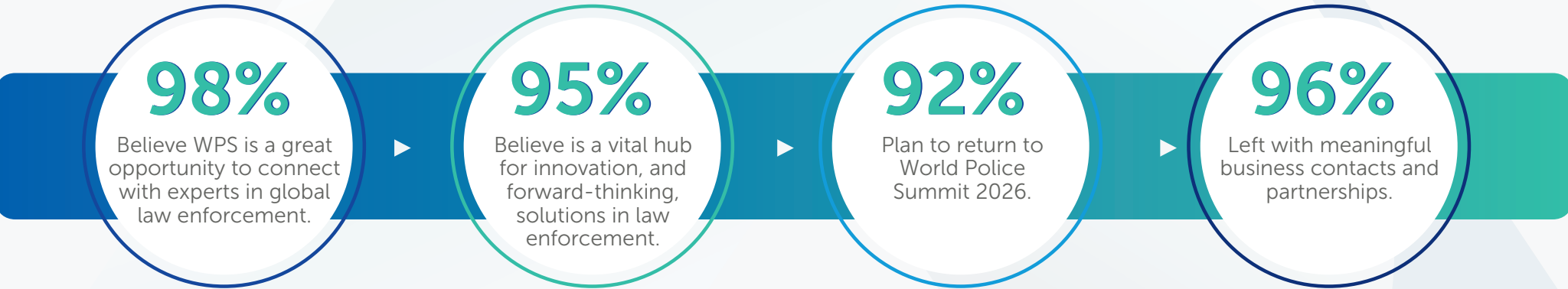

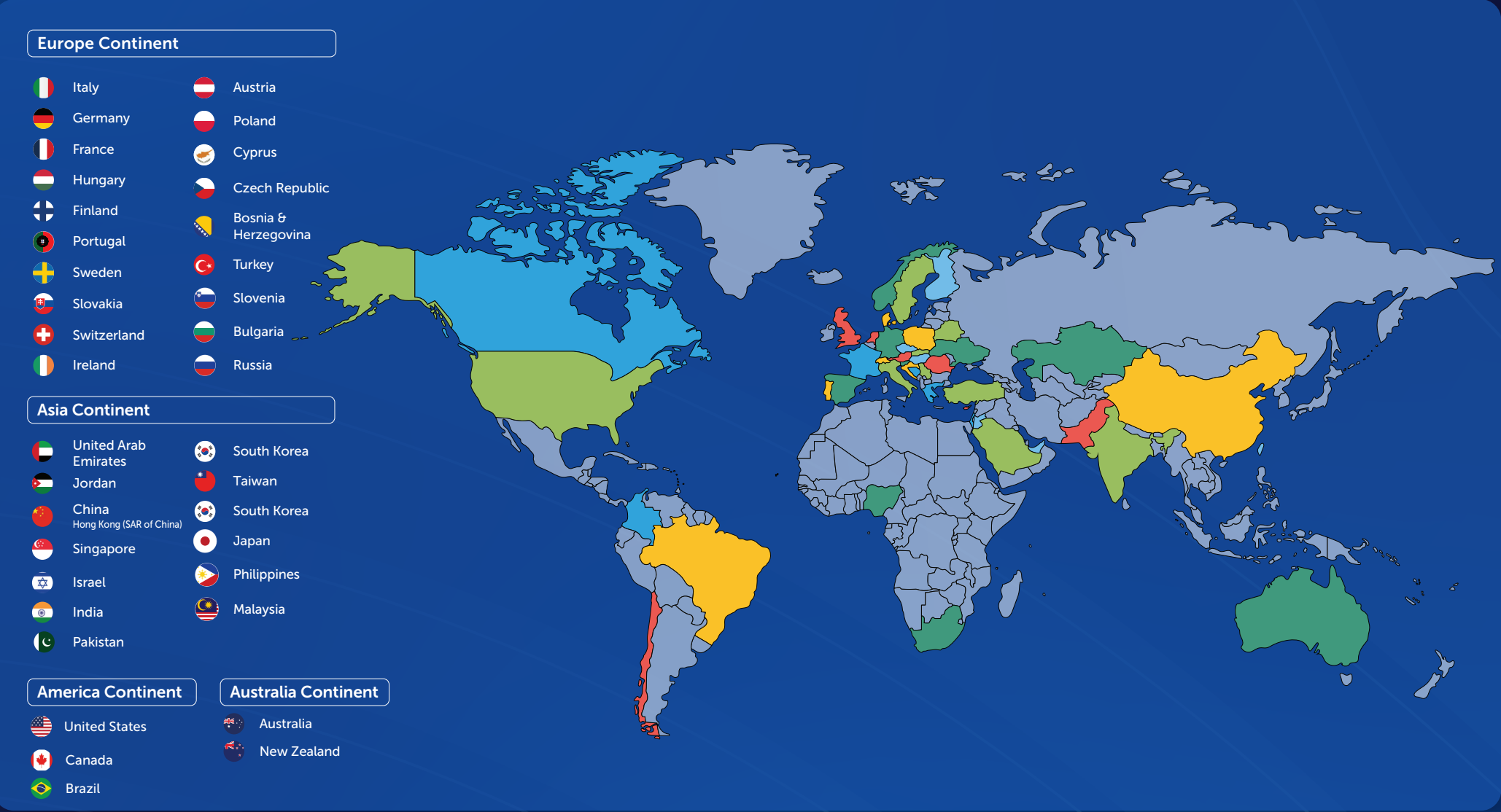

Bringing together experts in law enforcement, data, and innovation, the track offered a forward-thinking vision of how digital transformation is redefining modern policing.



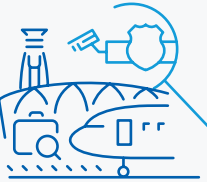
